

THE 110TH ANNUAL OJAI VALLEY TENNIS TOURNAMENT

APRIL 22-24, 2010

One Hundred-Eighth Annual

Southern California CIF Championships

Open to boys from member schools of the Los Angeles City, San Diego, Southern and Central Sections of the CIF.

Players should check with their school coach about application for these events, not to the Tournament Director or the Ojai Valley Tennis Club.

Note: Online entries are not accepted.

Entries must be submitted to the CIF-Southern Section Office by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 17, 2010.

Entry fees are \$35.00 for singles, and \$40.00 per doubles team.

Not more than one singles player and one doubles team may enter from each school. Players may enter either CIF singles or CIF doubles, but may not enter any other tournament event.

Each of the foregoing CIF Sections has been allocated a maximum number of entries and will send entry forms to their member schools. Completed entries and entry fees must be returned by the school coach directly to the appropriate CIF Section office (to be forwarded to the CIF-Southern Section office). As this is an invitational event, each Section is responsible for determining its own entries.

School coach must be present at registration, to be held at the Ojai Valley Tennis Club office at 201 South Signal Street, Ojai (just south of the Ojai Post Office tower and west of Libbey Park), on the Wednesday evening before the tournament from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m., and at Libbey Park North Gate on Thursday morning from 6:30 - 8:00 a.m. Players are encouraged to represent their schools by wearing school uniforms.

Coaching is permitted in these CIF events.

CIF coaches will receive wristbands, and CIF players will receive CIF-issued registration cards, permitting entry to all tournament sites that charge admission. Coaches' spouses and family and friends of players will be required to purchase tickets to gain entrance to Libbey Park, Libbey Park South, the Ojai Valley Athletic Club and the Ojai Valley Inn courts. Tickets are not required at other tournament sites.

In addition to winner and runner-up awards, the Farnum Cup in Singles and the Wrightman Cups in doubles will be awarded. The John van B. Griggs Memorial Challenge Cup will be awarded to the school whose singles and doubles entries score the most total points.
